

Liverpool Garage Rock Band **alright (okay)** Reinvent Themselves on New Single, '**Boyz Noize**'

After spending a year rediscovering and refining their sound, Liverpool-based alt-rock band, **alright (okay)**, are set to drop their bold new single '**Boyz Noize**' on **13th May**. Pulling inspiration from the rowdiness of their live shows, '**Boyz Noize**' is an energetic earworm that can already be heard in packed-out basement shows around the UK.

'**Boyz Noize**' is the first taste of a refined **alright (okay)**. It's a track that moves at its own pace, pulls inspiration from various genres and showcases a band that have found the sound they've been chasing for years. The result is an uncompromising fusion between garage rock and punk that cements the reasons why their headline shows consistently sell out.

Although the sound is heavier and a sharp left turn away from the lo-fi indie rock aesthetic of their early releases, **alright (okay)** stay true to what has made them a significant band in Liverpool's underground scene over the last three years.

Driven by a steady, head-bobbing beat and crunchy guitar tones, the single ebbs and flows between crunchy verse sections and earworm choruses, with guitarist and vocalist, **Will Booth**, taking centre stage. As the song transitions into a danceable double time section, the amps are dialled up to 11 and **Alex Usher's** commanding, punk vocals take centre stage over a wave of untamed drums and shrieking guitar.

In 2024, **alright (okay)** have already road tested their new material alongside the likes of **TV Priest** and **Alien Chicks**, debuting unreleased music to rowdy crowds across the North West.

To celebrate this release, **alright (okay)** will play a stacked release show presented by **Boot Music Magazine at Quarry in Liverpool on 17th May 2024**, with support coming from **WULL** and **Paint Me In Colour**.

Alex Usher comments, "*Boyz Noize was a freeing song for us to write. It was one of the first tracks we wrote after taking a short break and it completely revitalised the band. It gave us a whole new energy and you can definitely hear that on the record.*"

"The song name came from us messing about in the studio. One of the guys suggested it and we all found it stupid but funny. Next thing you knew it had stuck! It's a good thing it matches the fun feeling of the song."
